Footnotes

BIG BUSINESS chased the pace dispute, was angled four wide from the five-sixteenths pole, engaged the second place finisher just past the three-sixteenths pole, was the first of those two to arrive at the furlong marker, kicked well clear thereafter, drifted out slightly in the late stages while finishing under a brisk hand ride. CONSORTIUM pressed the pace as the widest of three until the quarter pole, fought his way to a narrow and short-lived advantage in upper stretch, had it taken away by the winner by the eighth pole, lost contact with that foe but held on well enough for the place. RELOAD raced along the outside, gave chase under encouragement, turned for home under a full drive, altered course to the rail in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, scurried into contention by midstretch then got outfinished. GAME TOKEN saved ground and failed to menace. HANNIBAL LECTER along the inside, argued for the front with another pair, had the middle member back away coming to the quarter pole, relinquished to the runner up after an abbreviated duel in upper stretch and faltered. REIN KING raced the widest on the turn, three to four wide altogether, folded. GROUND FORCE three wide and set down by the three-eighths pole, tired. THE PRIZE FIGHTER disputed the pace from between rivals until nearing the quarter pole, gave way. PERSON OF INTEREST bobbled at the break and was always outrun.
