KEY CENTS, just off the pace early on, rallied hard five wide in the stretch, dueled late and kept a slight edge. SUNNY MELODY was rated back, rallied through heavy traffic in the stretch and just missed. BRAC DRIFTER stalked the pace, had to duel inside through the stretch and was not good enough. NINTH INNING was just off the pace, had to rally hard five wide and had a late lead but was outfinished. DAILY REFLECTION was unhurried early on had a late rally four wide to be gaining late. FLAMINGO WAY stalked the early pace, was urged to close stretch but weakened. EFFERVESCENCE, with a mild early move failed to sustain bid. THIS BLISS saved ground but had no rally. STACEY TRACEY had the early pace, dueled through turn to mid stretch and gave way abruptly. THREE PACK dueled for the lead into upper stretch and gave way.
