### Footnotes

DRIVEN BY SOLAR dueled early in the two path, shook loose in upper stretch and drew off to a lengthy score under a vigorous hand ride. BELIEVE IN LOVE raced in midpack, rallied four wide at the quarter pole but was no match for the winner. VIRTUES UNDER FIRE dueled inside the winner to the top of the stretch and gradually tired thereafter. NEARLY THERE checked after being pinched back at the start and was never close thereafter. PENT UP saved ground to no avail. WE'RE GOING MOBILE steadied between horses at the half mile pole and never reached contention. SAMURAI MOON chased between horses for a half and tired. MAXIMUS PROSPECTOR steadied sharply in the early stages and again at the half mile pole and was never close thereafter.
