TONIGAIL set the pace on the inside, responded when asked and drew clear under urging. WISE CHOICE stalked in the two path and chased the winner home. ALYKELA saved ground and rallied mildly on the rail. THERE GOES MOLLY raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the lane and gained mildly outside. LIFE'S MEASURE raced off the rail, between rivals on the far turn and lacked a rally. AURIC GIRL had a three wide trip and tired. RED TO POSITIVE raced three wide early, then four wide on the backside and failed to threaten. G. A. EMPRESS was outrun.
