CHAIRMAN NOW broke well and quickly took control, was guided over to the inside, set moderate splits, rating kindly on what amounted to being an open and uncontested lead, showed no interest in the hint of pressure building up midway on the far turn, waited until turning for home being getting asked for some run, lengthened away to a comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong, had it cut into sizably in the late stages by the second place finisher to no avail. GIANT INDIAN stalked the winner from the outside without ever posing a danger, easily held off the others for the place. POINT TAKEN tracked the top one while taking the inside route, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, got outfinished. BAIL OUT THE BANKS strung out four wide on both turns, tired. SKY MUSIC strung out three wide on both turns, tired. STUD MUFFIN saved ground throughout, loped along one-paced until the quarter pole, was put to some encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, failed to pick up interest. SMALLTOWNMAN raced three wide on the opening bend, angled over sharply departing the backstretch to be less wider on the subsequent one, folded.
