SHEZA CLASSY LADY stumbled at the start, rated unkindly in the two path, pulling with vigor against the left side of the bit, until the five-sixteenths pole, settled down instantly when let out a notch commencing to angle outward from that station, fanned slightly past the four path turning for home, got straightened away and began to close in on the front runners, scooted by in the final seventy yards under strong hand encouragement to prove best. ALIRAVEN along the inside, dueled with DISCREET LADY, lightly hand urged while doing so, entered the stretch with the previously named rival on almost dead even terms and got called upon, was still on nearly even terms with that opponent a furlong later, yielded to the winner leaving the sixteenth pole, but gamely dug in to preserve place honors. DISCREET LADY stumbled badly at the start, moved up gradually to confront the runner up and initiate a prolonged pace fight, sparred with that rival heads apart the entire way around the bend, was called upon for much more as the battle spilled over into the stretch, remained in combat with her nemesis the remainder of the way, with only the show award to show for all the effort. KIKI CHACER patiently perched three wide off the embattled pair, was under encouragement spinning into the lane, proved no match for either one of them. MON ROSE got off a beat slowly, was guided over to the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, rode it until approaching the head of the stretch, was angled outward to no avail.
