SWISS TART contested the pace from between rivals until upper stretch, went at it one on one with ULTIMO PRINCIPE thereafter, dug in with good determination and refused to yield to that rival. ULTIMO PRINCIPE coaxed from the two path while sitting well-placed off a three way pace dispute, availed of the opportunity to angle out in the three path once the outermost member of the previously described battle began to back away late on the turn, was put to a right handed whip and bid in earnest turning for home, got engaged in a spirited tussle with the winner soon afterwards, failed to go by. CHASING MOONLIGHT raced from off the inside, was fanned six wide into upper stretch and rallied for the show. HEWITTS raced along the inside, got hounded by another pair, although not the same two until the furlong grounds, drifting out while tiring in the last eighth. TEMECULA CREEK rode the rail for the opening half, was already under solid encouragement getting guided into the three path by the three-sixteenths pole, failed to muster up a solid closing punch. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN three wide, pressed the issue as the widest of a trio until the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. NACHO SAINT briefly in midpack, departed the backstretch from the three path and tired.
