STREET LIFE rated off the pace in the four path, advanced his position through the final turn, reached the front nearing the furlong pole then moved clear late under steady handling. LISA'S ROYAL GUY raced unhurriedly while not far back, advanced off the rail nearing the final turn, made a run at the winner from the top of the stretch but settled for place. DR. ROCKETT was steadied briefly early, raced unhurriedly toward the outside, made a five wide bid on the final turn and finished evenly. DANGLING NUMBERS rated with the pace on the inside, took a short lead nearing the quarter pole, was clear entering the stretch but weakened from the eighth pole. GOLDEN SLEW rated just off the pace inside, dropped back angling out through the final turn and finished widest. SHYBYNATURE kept up with the early pace three wide and between rivals then weakened through the final turn. FILM STAR rated with the pace off the rail then gave way in the upper stretch. DIXIE STRIPES was through early.
