CLASSIC ENDEAVOR rated the pace inside, remained under a firm hold through the final turn, was pressured into the stretch and held on well with steady encouragement. EVENING ATTIRE was off slowly, rated back toward mid track, started his drive into the final turn, closed through the stretch and finished well. COLITA rated off the pace inside, made his bid entering the stretch, dueled on the rail but was outfinished for place. KISSIN SAINT rated off the pace about the four path, lost some momentum in the upper stretch, angled out making his bid and finished well. ZAKOCITY rated just off the early pace about the four path, began his push into the final turn then leveled off at the eighth pole. HYDROGEN rated back in the four path and finished evenly. COUNTRY BE GOLD never factored. ROARING FEVER rated off the pace toward mid track then tired inside. ADMIRALTY ARCH rated close just off the rail, drew near on the final turn toward the quarter pole then faded through the stretch.
