HARLINGTON raced in hand outside early, rallied four wide on the second turn and drew away late, driving. GOLDEN MAN pressed the pace from the outside and dug in gamely on the rail to hold the place. CROWN POINT was rated along outside, raced three wide and finished well outside. COSMOS MARINER was rated along inside, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally. LEADING THE PARADE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. TAKING THE REDEYE raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. DADDY JOE set the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters.
