Footnotes

CLOUD NINE staked the leader while travelling in the three path, made a successful move for the lead turning for home, extended his advantage by midstretch then continued to increase the winning margin while being kept busy. BELLAGIO rode the rail until being eased outward approaching the top of the stretch, was put to encouragement from the quarter pole and finished well to gain the place. MASTERWORK pressed the pace from the two path until the head of the stretch, was outkicked during the stretch drive. GREAT EMPEROR bumped at the start, was unhurried during the opening half, ducked to the rail at quarter pole and displayed a mild rally. MONTELEONE was bumped at the start, remained forwardly placed while wide, lacked a rally when called upon. CALL TIGER raced along the outside and was no factor. MERLIN CIRCLE bobbled after lunging at the break, was bumped as well soon afterwards, failed to reach a contending position. HI DADDY was steadied after the start, had a three wide trip and tired. J J'S PROPHET broke outward, causing a series of bumps at the start, cut the pace for about a half before fading out of the picture.
