WINNING TOUCH raced close up outside, bid three wide, responded when asked in upper stretch and edged away late, driving. ELTISH STAR raced three wide off the pace, came wide and finished well outside. DRIVEN BY SOLAR dueled two wide and dug in gamely inside the winner through the stretch run. NEW YAWKER raced between rivals on the turn and rallied mildly outside. CORNERSTONE chased three wide, four wide on the turn and weakened. NO QUESTIONS chased inside and tired. QUEPOS chased between rivals and tired. MONTE CARLO bobbled at the break, raced inside and lacked a late response. DIABLE TONNERRE did not factor. MULTITUDE dueled inside, gave way and was eased late.
