SUCCESSFULLY SWEET rated the pace from the inside, was under pressure leaving the final turn and lasted all out. SEEKING THE ANTE stumbled a stride out, rated just off the pace in the three path, closed under steady pressure through the stretch and finished well. PELHAM BAY rated close two deep, challenged the winner from the top of the stretch but leveled off toward the wire. RAHYS' APPEAL rated back inside, lacked room through the final turn, was blocked midstretch and finished well toward the rail. KARAKORUM SPLENDOR stumbled badly at the start, recovered quickly and settled into stride outside, gave chase into the final turn but proved empty in the drive. SHOOT THE BUGLER was rated back off the rail and lost contact on the final turn.
