**Footnotes**

STARGLEAM was reserved for a half, rallied three wide on the turn then drew off under good handling. INDYMINE was unhurried while saving ground, split horses while gaining on the turn then finished well along the rail and returned bleeding. MCGLAMERY ROAD raced up close along the rail, opened a clear lead on the turn and weakened in the final eighth. ECRU EGRET raced well back for six furlongs and rallied belatedly. LOFTY BANNER steadied along the rail on the first turn, made a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. FOUR STAR BO reared at the start causing the rider to come out of the irons and failed to threaten thereafter. TWO DECADES chased four wide and tired. RED DEMON was never a factor. DUKE OF DE BUQE was used up setting the early pace. BURNS UP THE TRACK steadied with the rider coming out of the irons on the first turn, raced up close along then inside and gave way on the turn.
