REGGIE D sat reserved for nearly a half, turned for home as the widest of the three front runners and poked a head down in front, got put to strong handling, kicked well clear of the rest during the run through the furlong grounds, extended the margin even more under a brisk hand ride. CAMERON CANYON drew alongside BWANA BOOYAH nearing the end of the backstretch, sparred with that foe while taking the two path, had the winner make his presence more pronounced coming to the end of the backstretch, dropped back when unable to keep pace, but continued on well enough for the place. RAFFIE'S STAR tracked the duelers while sitting the pocket until the five-sixteenths pole, vacated the premises at that stage and entered the stretch under a drive, made no headway on the front runners. STONE PICKER got outthusted leaving the starting gate, raced around the turn near the inside and under a prolonged drive, failed to reach a contending position. BWANA BOOYAH outward a couple of steps at the start, clearly outbroke the field to gain the early advantage, argued for command from the inside for almost a half, came under intensified pressure approaching the quarter pole, got put to a drive a couple of jumps before arriving there, yielded quickly and faltered. SNACKS under a snug hold between rivals at the half mile pole, entered the stretch three wide under urging, tired. FIRSTBELLATHENKK chased three wide, folded. SAGUARO BLOSSOM in three path at the three-eighths pole, was outrun.
