VILLANESCA was put to some hand urging nearly from the get-go, chased the front runners while racing along the outside, got set down to a strong drive after spinning into the lane, altered course to the outside in midstretch, forged her way to the lead and edged away, kept to the task at hand. ROMAN RENEGADE got bumped soundly from between rivals at the start, with the rider grabbing hold after the second one, was guided over to the inside coming to the turn, stayed there for less than a quarter, angling to the outside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to procure the place. CATINATREE bumped soundly just after the start, settled near the front, departed the backstretch from the three path and ranged up to the leader, went by take over by a slim margin late on the turn, got let out soon afterwards, came under heavy pressure from the eventual winner, relinquished for good past the furlong marker and weakened. E Z PASSER took the overland route to no avail. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER three to four wide on the turn, tired. LEAD ME ON made solid contact with the runner up at the start, was outrun thereafter. MUSIC CLUB BELLE lost her footing at the break, quickly took the lead and quickly tucked along the rail, yielded when tested sternly by CATINATREE just as the opening half was being completed, stayed a prominent factor until deep into the furlong grounds then backed away.
