WINEKEEPER stalked outside, moved up three wide on the turn, put a head in front a sixteenth out and dug in gamely. SUMMERTIME FRIEND stumbled at the start, vied inside, dug in and weakened. FIERCE BOOTS was bumped lightly at the start, raced off the pace and closed belatedly outside. KETEL TWIST vied two wide and weakened. STORM SWEPT was bumped lightly at the start, chased inside and lacked a bid.
