MISS DA POINT tracked inside, came out for the drive, rallied outside of TRAIL WALKER, put a head in front past the sixteenth pole and was all out to hold on. MADRE DITUTTICAPI hesitated at the break and was off slowly, caught up to the field on the turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed willingly outside and just missed. TRAIL WALKER vied inside, dug in gamely and yielded late. SO BLESSED saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. GIRL CODE raced five wide early, vied outside and weakened. GARMENTOS GIRL raced off the pace, moved up three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. BROADWAY MUSIC GAL raced four wide early, between rivals on the turn and failed to respond.
