IT ALL ADDS UP showed good speed along the inside while in hand, drew away to a long lead in the stretch and was kept to a drive to the wire. MILA was outrun early, rallied four wide and finished well but could not get near the winner. FAVORITE ENDING was outrun early and offered a mild rally outside. GETLUCKYSOMETIME was rated along inside, was steadied repeatedly and posed no real threat. QUEEN CANDACE raced with the pace from the outside and tired after three quarters. SWEEP DREAMS raced close up and tired in the stretch. BAYOU BLUES chased outside and tired.
