REIGN OF TARA rated close in the three path, made her bid entering the stretch, dueled the final furlong and edged ahead from the sixteenth pole. PRINCESS LANIQUE rated just off the pace inside, started her bid from the top of the stretch, was eased out near the eighth pole, just up for place and closing in on the winner. SAFELY AT HOME pressured the pace from the inside, contested the turn then continued with a short lead through late stretch but grudgingly yielded the final yards. VIRGIN VOYAGE showed no speed, was five wide through the turn and finished evenly outside. JACQUI'S PROMISE steadied briefly at the start, rated off the pace in the three path and finished evenly. DEACON LAKE was steadied dropping back early, hustled back to contention, ran four wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. CARSON COVE set a pressured pace off the rail, dueled through the upper stretch then weakened.
