NAOS within striking distance while off the inside, swung outward after turning for home, had a change of heart after a couple of strides, altering course back inward at the three-sixteenths, rallied in earnest when set down, reached even terms with the leader at the eighth pole and edged away under a drive. STORM DOOR raced three wide, worked his way to a slim advantage in upper stretch after being put to a stiff drive, matched strides with the top one briefly before relinquishing the lead leaving the furlong marker, continued on well to be a clear second. SOBHY swung five wide turning for home and displayed a mild rally to be along for the show. BINDLE STICK improved his position by outfinishing weakening rivals. DON'TFIGHTTHEFED underwent a four wide journey and tired. DUKES ALLEY pressed the pace for a half and faltered. MARITAL COURT saved ground to no avail. SHABAAB cut the pace along the rail, faded fast during the final furlong. UPSELL very wide along the backstretch, dropped back while racing greenly, was pulled up and walked off the track.
