MISSILE MOTOR was eased back early, rallied outside on the turn, took charge in midstretch and drew off under urging. KING BO BO checked a bit at the half mile pole, saved ground to the turn then finished willingly for the place. WILD CONGA dueled for a half, gained a brief lead on the turn and weakened. UNBRIDLED DANGER was never a factor. THE VIN MAN failed to threaten while saving ground. NATURAL SPEED was used up dueling for the early lead.
