IBBOYEE stumbled at the start, tucked in on the rail leaving the first turn, settled inside for a half, split rivals three wide on the turn, closed the gap in midstretch then wore down CITY TROOPER in hand through the final seventy yards. CITY TROOPER pressed the pace three wide between horses, made a move to challenge on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch, battled into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. SHRIMP DANCER was carried out on the first turn, stalked four wide for five furlongs, edged closer on the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. DONT BLAME THE CAT pressed the pace in the two path, gained a slim lead on the turn and weakened in midstretch. VITAL ARGUMENT set a pressured pace along the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. GOLLY DAY raced in traffic at the half mile pole, was outrun while wide to the turn and lacked a late response. READING GROUP failed to threaten while between horses.
