Footnotes

LEVERAGEDTOTHEHILT the early leader, gave up the front to her stable mate near the midway point down the backstretch, patiently prompted that one from the two path, with another pair in close proximity parked out in lanes three and four respectively for most of the way around the bend, moved when ready and took over in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, edged away from the others to lead the field into the stretch with none latched on, drew off, crossing the wire under a brisk hand drive. BARGAINING TABLE broke about a length behind the winner at the start, was guided over towards the rail almost immediately afterwards, appeared eager, was given enough rein and rushed up to grab the advantage before reaching the end of the backstretch, cut the pace for a good portion of the way around the bend, relinquished without putting up much fight, held on well enough in the late stages to salvage second. LAZULITE chased the front runners three wide, missed out on second. GUYANA STAR saved ground on the turn, made no serious bids. YEARS WILL ROLL under the whip spinning four wide into the stretch, had no impact. YOUNGWILDANDFREE broke inward, brushing with the nearest opponent, departed the backstretch from the four path, remained a prominent factor for almost a half before backing away. PRINCES ON THELAKE carried in slightly by YOUNGWILDANDFREE at the start, raced along the outside, was under encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, tired.
