STAR CHIEF pressured the early pace, dropped back inside nearing the turn, lacked room through the upper stretch, made his bid when clear and sustained a long drive to get up late. SAFE IN THE U S A set a pressured pace off the rail, was under a solid drive while drifting slightly outward and outfinished late. VINEMEISTER pressured the pace from the outside, was six wide through the turn, tried to savage HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMP leaving the turn, leaned all over that one through the upper stretch and finished well, gaining late. MAGIC AND BIRD was steadied briefly at the start, angled outward leaving the turn and finished evenly in mid track. HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMP pressed the pace five wide, was steadied slightly entering the stretch, in tight nearing the eighth pole and was empty from there. KENDRICK chased the pace off the rail then leveled out. MAX JONES pressured the pace from the three path, looked a factor entering the stretch then faded.
