JAZIL was outrun early, came wide into the stretch, settled suddenly leaving the eighth pole and was up with a rush from the outside, driving. TASTEYVILLE contested the pace from the outside, drew clear nearing the stretch, turned back a bid from SCOTS PINE in upper stretch, was clear into deep stretch and was caught in the final strides. SCOTS PINE raced close up outside, rallied three wide on the second turn, tried the winner in upper stretch and tired. ERNIE BOGEN had no rally. NORTH EAST STORM contested the pace along the inside and tired. THUNDER PROOF lost contact with the field after the opening half mile and was eased. A claim of foul against the second place finisher by the rider of the third place finisher, alleging interference in upper stretch, was dismissed.
