Footnotes

SHIPMAKER grabbed the lead soon after the start, was kept at a slight distance off the rail while being pressed by a pair during the run around the bend, and with others in close proximity as well, got set down commencing the drive two wide, had the runner up draw up to loom a serious threat by the end of the furlong grounds, was fed steady right handed stick work to remain entrenched in the two path, dug in stubbornly to preserve the decision. DATTTTS HAPPY underwent a ground-saving journey, was put to some encouragement nearly from the get-go, left the half mile pole having been put to a drive, advanced readily from upper to midstretch to latch on to the top one and pose a major danger, continued to cut into that one's margin, came up short. BURNED BRIDGES unhurried from the outside for almost a half, picked up the pace approaching the head of the stretch, got placed five wide and rallied willingly for the show. EXCESS LIQUIDITY off the inside and off a pace fight, turned for home four wide and being urged along, mustered up a mild kick to grab the last major check. CROSS GATE chased the winner three wide, with another parked just to his outside until late on the turn, gave way. HE AIN'T BLUFFING chased the winner from the two path and from between rivals for much of the opening half, tired. M P JOE off a beat slowly, saved ground, felt the whip cutting the corner into the lane, undertook a laborious maneuver starting from the three-sixteenths pole that carried him into the fsix path by midstretch, made no significant headway on the front runners. INDIANA MOON four wide departing the backstretch, tired. ALPHA ZUMBA in the overland route on the turn, folded.
