### Footnotes

FLORES ISLAND contested the early pace three wide, then stalked, bid three wide on the turn, battled back inside to regain command in midstretch and drew clear. DULCEDUMBRE stalked outside a rival, made a four wide bid on the turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, could not stay with the winner and was all out to hold the place. HOLIDAY'S JEWEL vied between rivals and weakened. E Z PASSER tracked inside, moved up three wide passing the quarter pole and lacked a rally. RAIN FOREST vied inside and faded. WILDICHI was outrun.
