Footnotes

SPOLETO was bumped at the start, set the pace, drew clear and was ridden out. DISARMING was outrun early, came three wide into the lane and rallied outside. GIUSEPPINA was bumped at the start, settled off the rail and gained mildly outside. OLIVE EYE chased the pace, bid at the quarter pole and weakened. BOBITY BOO chased outside and tired. NORTHERN WARRIOR saved ground and lacked a rally.
