ZEALOUS BOY tracked inside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and kicked clear under urging. DIGGER KARAKORUM dueled outside and came up second best. PETE'S PARLEY was bumped at the start, dueled inside and weakened. BARREL OF LOVE was off slowly, saved ground, came out and was outfinished late for third. FIRST DAY chased outside and tired. DOAST broke out and bumped READING GROUP hard at the start, raced off the pace, then was impeded and pulled up on the turn. READING GROUP was bumped hard at the start, then bumped hard by his stablemate on the turn, stumbled and lost the rider. AHEADOFTHEJONESES chased inside, veered out slamming READING GROUP entering the turn, fell and was vanned off, bled. After a Stewards' Inquiry the race was declared official.
