SAN PABLO latched on to the runner up shortly after the start, applied honest pressure prompting that rival, bid in earnest midpoint on the second bend, grabbed away the advantage from a much more energetically-handled foe and got called upon himself shortly afterwards, edged away slowly but steadily during the run through the furlong grounds, had GALLANT FIELDS stage a valiant comeback attempt with a sixteenth to go, but dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. GALLANT FIELDS away without incident at the start, gained a narrow lead and was sent over to the inside, cut the fractions under the watchful eye of the top one, came under heavy pressure from that opponent leaving the three-eighths pole and was soon asked for run, relinquished but stayed within striking distance, altered course to be outside the winner in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and closed in well belatedly to make things a bit interesting at the end. ISN'T HE PERFECT got bumped in the hind quarters leaving the homestretch, sat reserved for off the inside until nearing the half mile pole, tipped into the three path and ranged up then sat parked out there keeping pace with front runners, got let out a notch and issued a challenge coming to the quarter pole, wasn't up to the task at hand and quickly fell back, continued on willingly for the show. INDY SCENT appeared to climb early down the backstretch over the wet going, saved ground until midway on the far turn, vacated the inside route to steer past a tiring rival at the juncture, spun into the lane, lacked the needed stretch response. ARCH TRAVELER got outthustled, was a bit rank heading for the opening turn and went on to bump with ISN'T HE PERFECT, underwent a ground-saving ground, failed to respond when asked for run at the end of the backstretch and faded.
