COUGAR RIDGE trailed the field, came four wide into the lane, closed strongly outside, drifted in while clear past the eighth pole and pulled away. MR PALMER was a bit slow into stride, settled off the rail, then three wide, bid three wide on the turn, briefly put a head in front, steadied slightly behind the winner and dug in for the place. TWO IS TO MANY set the pace, dueled on the turn and stayed on well. POINT TAKEN raced off the pace inside, continued on the rail turning for home and lacked a serious rally. PARK CITY raced close up inside, then between rivals, came three wide into the lane and had no rally. READTHEBYLINE was fractious in the gate, stalked two wide, bid two wide on the turn and tired. A Jockey's Objection by the rider of MR PALMER against the winner, was dismissed.
