TWOTIME contested the pace while between rivals and continued on gamely through the stretch. EVIL DEED outrun early, circled widest into the stretch and finished gamely from the far outside. KNOW THE FACTS stumbled badly at the start, chased the pace while four wide and lacked a rally. GRENDA contested the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. DANCEROSYDANCE raced three wide and lacked a solid closing kick. SWEEPING HOURS contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. PLAINTIFF raced inside and had no response when roused. JANE raced inside and had no rally. AMATURE NIGHT had no response when roused.
