ARRESTED showed good speed from the start, raced with the pace while between rivals, drew clear when asked for run and was kept to a drive to remain clear to the finish. BESTBANDINTHELAND rated along inside, swung wide into the stretch and dug in gamely to outfinish BOODLES for the place spot. BOODLES raced close up inside while in hand, rallied between rivals on the second turn and was outfinished for the place award. DEPUTY GENERAL raced with the pace along the rail and had no response when roused. GURU raced wide on both turns and was carried out entering the stretch. INSIYABI tired after a wide trip. CAYMAN CAT chased the pace while wide and tired in the stretch. CERTAINLY CLASSIC raced with the pace while three wide and tired.
