Footnotes

VERI LIGHT rated close toward the outside, was on even terms through the final turn, had the lead nearing the quarter pole, dueled clear late stretch then held off a late challenge from the runner up. GLORIOUS JENNA raced unhurriedly toward the outside, started her bid four wide on the final turn, closed with a late rush but was outfinished. CRY OF THE CAT was kept just off the pace, bid five wide on the final turn, dueled through the upper stretch then leveled out from the eighth pole. LADY LYDIA rated close off the rail, took a short but brief lead on the final turn then tired on the rail. DIAMONDS FOR LIL rated a clear early lead, was pressured through the backstretch, checked on the rail entering the final turn and was empty through the stretch. GRAND SCHEME showed no speed toward the inside, angled out nearing the quarter pole then tired outside. DESERT BLOOM was kept off the early pace then gave way after half.
