CITY SPIRIT was taken back a bit entering the backstretch, content to stalk the pacesetter from the outside, continued to bide her time until the second turn, gradually ranged up during the run around the far bend, responded positively when asked turning for home. had no trouble displacing the leader, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and held sway under active handling. LUCK outrun early, found her best stride upon reaching the far turn, scurried into contention along the inside, angled outward at the three-sixteenths pole, then sustaining her momentum, finished with good energy to secure the place. SAY TOBA SANDY saved ground until the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. ONE IN A ROMP took the inside route, was steadied and forced to alter course outward to avoid being boxed in approaching the eighth pole, lacked a strong closing kick thereafter. TWISTAWAY cut the fractions for six furlongs, gave way readily once challenged turning for home. CITY IN THE CLOUDS was no threat. ARISTO three wide around the second turn, was no menace. SO SMASHLEY raced three wide around the far turn, was tiring when the rider lost the whip in upper stretch.
