J L BERNSTEIN dueled along the rail the entire way and prevailed after a long drive. VINNIE VAN GO settled inside leaving the first turn, raced up close for six furlongs, angled out in upper stretch and closed steadily to narrowly gain the place. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK was strung out wide on the first turn, contested the pace from outside into deep stretch and was nipped late for the place. ASK OMMADON steadied in traffic between horses on the first turn, lodged a mild move between horses to reach contention on the turn and finished evenly. MONASTIR stumbled at the start, saved ground while closing the gap on the turn and flattened out. LONGING FOR MALIBU failed to threaten while racing wide. GOOD KARMA saved ground to no avail. HUE AND CRY chased three wide and gave way on the turn.
