EVERY LITTLE THING was reserved for a half, gained four wide on the turn then drew off to a lengthy score while being kept to the task. DUGOUT DEPUTY settled just off the pace four wide to the turn and gained late to get up for the place. CATCHAPENNY K. saved ground and rallied belatedly. LOYAL SHADOW pressed the pace from outside, gained a slim lead on the turn and weakened late. CENTRINA chased in the two path and lacked a late response. KARAKORUM JETE was used up dueling along the rail. DISCREET FLING failed to mount a serious rally. LUNA CLARA was finished after going a half. YOU DE BEST raced up close in hand and gave way on the far turn. VICTORIOUS SONG stumbled at the start unseating the rider in the process. Following a stewards inquiry there was no change in the order of finish.
