MORE THAN A REASON was content to trail, advanced on the far turn, swung wide turning for home, closed willingly outside and prevailed under a drive. STORMY'S MAJESTY pressed the pace, commenced his bid at the quarter pole, gained a short lead and dug in gamely on the rail to the end. ARSON SQUAD was well placed inside, split rivals in midstretch and closed gamely between horses. MODERN COWBOY had a three wide trip, made a bid at the quarter pole and weakened. SENIORS PRIDE set the pace on the inside and weakened. PEDROLINO pulled and was steadied in the early stages, tracked and failed to respond.
