FIRE KING alternated for the lead along the inside for six furlongs, shook loose leaving the turn, extended his advantage in midstretch then held sway under intermittent right hand urging. LAS VEGAS ERNIE settled just behind the dueling leaders while saving ground to the turn then finished well along the inside to edge MR. SINATRA for the place. MR. SINATRA was rated just off the pace while three wide to the turn, fell back a bit in upper stretch, closed late to gain a share. EARLY WARNING moved up from outside to gain a slim lead nearing the first turn, dueled outside the winner to the top of the stretch then weakened from his early efforts. BRUSHING UP trailed to the turn and failed to threaten while improving his position. STEAK SCAM stumbled at the start, raced within striking distance to the turn and lacked a further response. STEADY CLIMB raced between horses for seven furlongs and gave way.
