SPAVINAW exchanged bumps at the start then firmly rated the pace, was tested nearing the end of the turn and responded willingly drawing clear then kept to a moderate drive. PIROETTE was brushed at the start, raced off the pace, ran six wide through the turn, rallied from the top of the stretch and dueled for the place. PERFECT ENDING rated close to the pace off the rail, angled five wide entering the stretch then closed with the runner up but weakened late. SEMINOLE GAL rated back saving ground, made a bid off the rail from upper stretch, closed the gap and finished evenly. BELLA ROUGE, off the pace, ran between horses on the turn and offered a mild belated bid. HOME DEED was brushed at the start and raced unhurriedly to the turn, had a mild advance widest on the turn then was empty outside through the stretch. DANCINGINTHERAIN was bumped then bobbed at the start, raced just off the pace through the backstretch, advanced to the outside on the turn, dueled briefly then dropped back entering the stretch and weakened late. BUSY stalked the pace from the inside then faded under a solid drive through the stretch. UPUPANDAWAY stalked the pace early on, chased the leaders through the turn, was steadied slightly nearing the quarter pole then gave way.
