SAINT LIAM was well placed just off the dueling leaders, bid three wide on the far turn and drew away in hand. PARIS SUNRISE saved ground early on, bid between foes and finished gamely outside for the place. NETCONG raced off the pace on the inside and rallied between rivals in the stretch. VOLKONSKY dueled inside and weakened. MR. DETERMINED raced three wide on the clubhouse turn, dueled outside for the lead and tired in the final furlong. AVENTURA PLACE had no rally. ONE COLONY did not factor. PARNELL SQUARE chased three wide and gave way. AVISO faded.
