Footnotes

WALL STREET WONDER stalked in hand for a half, made a run to challenge in midstretch and edged clear under under good handling. REREADTHEFOOTNOTES set the pace under pressure along the rail into midstretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. THE TRUFFLE MAN chased three wide for a half and drifted out while tiring. MONTECORE stumbled at the start, saved ground for a half, rallied inside in upper stretch, altered course to the outside in midstretch and lacked a late response. SUCCESS FEE never reached contention. STELLWAGEN pressed the pace between horses to the turn and gave way. NO QUESTIONS never reached contention while racing wide. REGAL PRINCE was far back after breaking slowly, swung five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a further response.
