MERLIN BAY was outrun early, advanced inside on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, rallied outside and was up late. ARTIE'S CHAPTER raced off the pace, rallied three wide past the quarter pole, drew clear a sixteenth out and was caught. GERARD LOVES BEER pulled early, set the pace and weakened in the final furlong. NOBODY LIKE MIKE chased outside a rival, angled out at the furlong marker and lacked a winning bid. MEASURE UP chased outside and tired. SLIGHT FEVER raced inside, split rivals turning for home and lacked a rally. TRUE THAT chased inside and tired. TAPPED OUT BRUNO raced off the rail and gave way.
