MISCHIEF MAKER attended the pace maker from just off the inside, got roused at the quarter pole, seized command nearing the eighth pole and went clear under a drive kept busy to the wire. READ THE RESEARCH set the pace inside accompanied by the aforementioned rival, was asked at the quarter pole, yielded the lead nearing the final furlong, proved no match while holding for the place honors. SALLY'S DREAM tracked the pace inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, kept on mildly through the stretch for the show while never threatening the winner. GUYANA PRINCESS saved ground towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the half mile pole, split foes at the quarter pole, offered up mild late foot for the last major share. LEMON SPLENDOR just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, swung four wide into the stretch and passed tired foes in the lane. PRINCESS MARA a bit rank early on under restraint, saved ground in mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths pole and offered no response. HOT SPLASH urged tracking two to three wide, was placed to a drive at the seven-sixteenths and weakened after a half. LA BELLA VALERIA three wide both turns towards the rear, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide in upper stretch and tired.
