Footnotes

TIZ THE ARGUMENT unsettled at the start when tossing her head, was off a beat slow as a result conceding two lengths to the front, was put to restraint early on settling towards the rear, came under a prolonged ride from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide for home progressing on the front offering up a steady kick until inside the final sixteenth, got on track surging late to just get up in the final strides and prevail. MOON PHILLY just off the pace two to three wide, came under a drive three furlongs from home, spun three to four wide into the stretch, took command just past the eighth pole, inched away to the sixteenth marker, was confronted in the final strides and caught on the wire in a good effort. CHECK POINT allowed to settle just off the inside at the rear, shifted to the rail at the half mile pole, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out for a clear lane a furlong out then kicked home belatedly for the show honors. OPUS A well rated on the pace along the inside, got set down at the quarter pole, yielded the front just past the eighth pole, kept on fighting until weakening in the late stages and was outfinished in the final strides while maintaining the last major share. THE UNDERLING well rated attending the pace from the two path, got let out at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and was out kicked in the stretch. KID KATE tracked inside from just off the pace under light coaxing, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened.
