Footnotes

BRUSHED ON, just off the pace on the inside, angled to the outside of the pacesetter in the upper stretch then rallied clear in the final sixteenth. BUDDHA'S DELIGHT raced off the pace, advanced through the backstretch, was steadied in the upper stretch then rallied from between horses leaving the eight pole, getting up for place. JUDGE'S CASE rated the pace, was asked for run from the inside through the stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. INFORMATION HIWAY stalked the pace, dropped back a notch into the stretch then leveled off late. PHONE THE KING, off the pace, was steadied on the inside nearing the far turn then offered a mild bid near the rail through the stretch. SEEKING THE DREAM was unhurried early on, made a minor move through the far turn then ran evenly through the stretch. SAINT JOSEPH was steadied into the first turn, raced just off the pace then chased the leader through the final turn and faded. MR. SINATRA was no factor.
