GRISHAM rated off the pace in the four path, was steadied lacking room at the quarter pole, eased out in midstretch and rallied clear the final yards. CLEAR DESTINY ran outside the opening turn, rated close in the four path on the backstretch, started her bid through the final turn, dueled gamely in the stretch but was outfinished the final yards while maintaining place. CHARMER'S IMAGE raced unhurriedly, angled out making her bid on the final turn, closed well toward the outside and just missed the place bob. ELECTION STAR rated close inside, made her bid around the tiring pacesetter into the final turn, dueled gamely with a short lead through the stretch but was outfinished. NAMASTE rated close from between horses, started a bid into the final turn, drew close in midstretch then leveled out. ROSIE'S SISTER rated off the pace toward the outside, made her bid widest on the final turn, was on even terms at the quarter pole then flattened stride. BEACH PARTY rated clear just off the rail, was pressured into the final turn, steadied slightly on the rail in the upper stretch then faded. DARLING BRIDE rated back on the inside, ran off the rail through the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. SKY COVER chased the pace from the inside, lacked room nearing the final turn then gave way into the stretch.
