RUN WITH THE LARK was placed under a firm hold while forced to bide his time behind rivals during the run around the far bend, angled outward after spotting clearance turning for home, quickly settled into stride after being straightened away and finished with good energy to win going away. TAKE THE BLUFF hustled away from the starting gate, found himself in a protracted speed duel with BE BULLISH for three-quarters while racing along the inside, shook free soon after entering the stretch, was powerless to turn back the top one's strong rally but continued on the end with good courage to garner place honors. NUMAANY well placed inside off a spirited speed duel, came up empty when asked in the lane. BE BULLISH made a three wide run around the opening bend to reach the front, got hooked up in a fierce speed battle with the runner up while travelling in the two path down the backstretch and around the far turn, began giving up ground soon after turning for home. PREMIUM GOLD was never involved. BOLD DESPERADO was no threat. ACAI forwardly placed for six furlongs, folded.
