WHEN IT RAINS was outrun early, launched a strong rally down the middle of the track and was up in the final yards, driving. YOU'RE ON YOUR OWN vied outside for the lead, gained a short advantage passing the furlong marker, drifted out a bit brushing MAGIC MATTY and weakened late while holding second. MS. AMOURS raced off the pace and rallied inside. MAGIC MATTY stumbled at the start, then advanced inside on the turn, angled out for the drive, was bumped slightly in deep stretch and outfinished. LIVEITUPNOW chased outside and tired. CASH BACK set a pressured pace on the inside and gave way in the final furlong. WHISPERED CALL did not factor. CALCE CLUNES faded.
